As a result, and in order to raise awareness amongst all the interested parties in the organisation, the management assumes, as a primordial objective, the commitment to **FULFILLING** the improvement of the environment in the port areas of action, in coherence with the activities and port services carried out by the organisation and its work infrastructures.

In order to attain and exceed this main objective, the management of **SERVIPOINT BALEAR** prepares and verifies its environmental management system in accordance with the requisites of the international standard **ISO 14001:2015**, with the continued implication of all of its human potential. To achieve this, it will work on:

- Ensuring the operations are developed fully respecting environmental and safety conditions.
- Preventing and minimising pollution of the sea, air and land in all of its operational and port services, applying the best coherent techniques to the organisation.
- Increasing and improving internal environmental awareness and training.
- Dealing with the environmental considerations of our signatories and shipping companies, users of the services and the interested parties within the organisation, in harmony with our objectives, with the aim of increasing synergy between the professionals from the sector.
- The absolute need to inform and raise awareness amongst our subcontractors and suppliers.
- Being responsible for identifying and fulfilling the applicable norms, and valuing other voluntary commitments to improving environmental technique.
- Collaborating with the public authorities for the correct provision of our services, with the main objective of minimising our environmental risks in the public port and maritime domain.

The management undertakes, with the participation of all of the members of the organisation, to promote this environmental policy so that it becomes a model for defining and establishing the goals and objectives of continuous improvement of environmental quality in our area of action in the Port of Palma and the Port of Alcúdia.

This policy is public and updated on all levels of the organisation, with resources assigned to put it into practice.
